

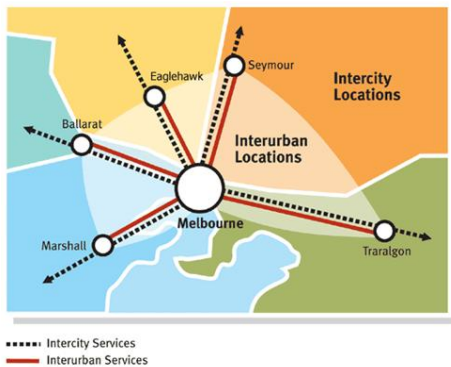
# V/Line travel tips – World’s Biggest Playgroup Day

## MAKING A RESERVATION

### Do I need to make a reservation?

Reservations must be made on all Intercity/long distance trains (Bairnsdale, Swan Hill, Shepparton and Warrnambool) and on some coach services.

You do not have to make a reservation on any Interurban/short distance train service (Marshall/Geelong/Ballarat/Eaglehawk/Seymour and Traralgon).



Reservations can be made:

- by calling **136 196**
- at staffed V/Line train stations and some premium Metro stations

## FAMILY TRAVELLER TICKET

Using our Family Traveller ticket, each adult can take up to 2 kids (4-16 years) free at off peak times. Kids under 4 years old travel free, but they must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

## FOOD AND DRINKS

Catering is available on trains to/from Bairnsdale, Swan Hill, Shepparton and Warrnambool. Snacks, tea, coffee and soft drinks are available for purchase.

Catering is not available on V/Line coaches, including rail replacement coaches. Passengers are welcome to bring their own food and non-alcoholic beverages onto trains and coaches.

## Your V/Line ticket is also a Metcard and a regional bus ticket

**Single** tickets include one hour free travel on the metropolitan network on either side of your V/Line journey.

**Return** tickets include a full day of free travel on the metropolitan network on the same day as your V/Line journey.

You can use your V/Line ticket to travel for FREE on local buses in the following regional cities:

Bendigo, Eaglehawk	Bendigo Transit Service	BTS

Remember, you must have your V/Line ticket with you when you board the bus. V/Line tickets are not available from the bus driver.

Travel by	Details
	From Southern Cross Railway Station walk about 570 metres to <b>119-Spencer St/La Trobe St (Melbourne City)</b>
	From 119-Spencer St/La Trobe St take the: <b>Route 30 tram towards Brunswick St; or Route 35 tram towards Spring Street; or Route 24 tram towards North Balwyn</b> Get off at <b>Stop 8-Exhibition St/La Trobe St (Melbourne City)</b>
	Walk about 570 metres to <b>Melbourne Museum/Rathdowne St (Carlton)</b>
