What you need...

- + Paper plate
- + Coloured card
- + Felt
- + Scissors
- + Sticky tape
- + String
- + Paint/textas/pencils
- + Icy pole sticks
- + Pipe cleaners



Inspiration:

Reuse everyday objects you have at home to create costumes. Dress-up as a doctor, mermaid, cowboy, an astronaut, an artist or a train driver using cardboard boxes, old clothes, paper plates and natural items such as leaves to decorate. What's your favourite animal? Are you feeling silly today or happy? Do you dream of flying? What do you want to be when you grow up? Chat and create!

What to do:

- 1. <u>Choose an animal or character (try using one of our Playgroup Pals!).</u>

- 4. Colour in the paper plates or paint on the animal's features.
