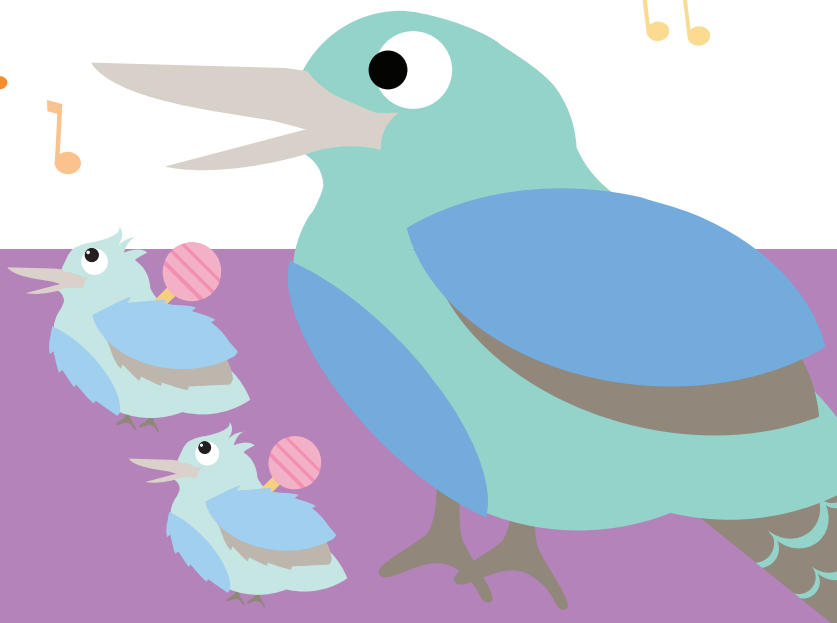

(touch nose with finger)

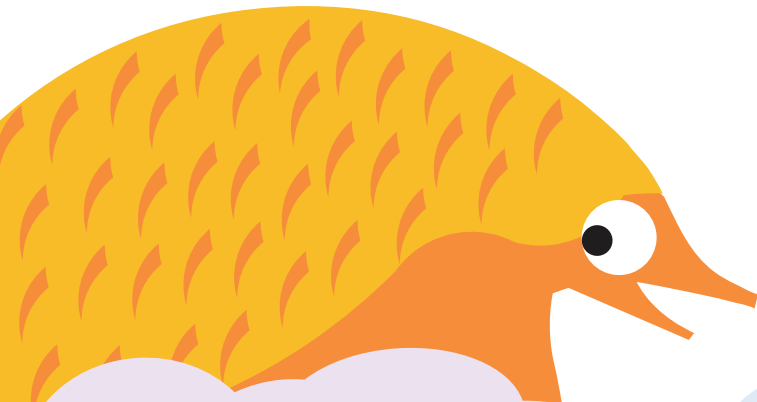


10 Little Bubbles

Bought a currant bun and took it away.



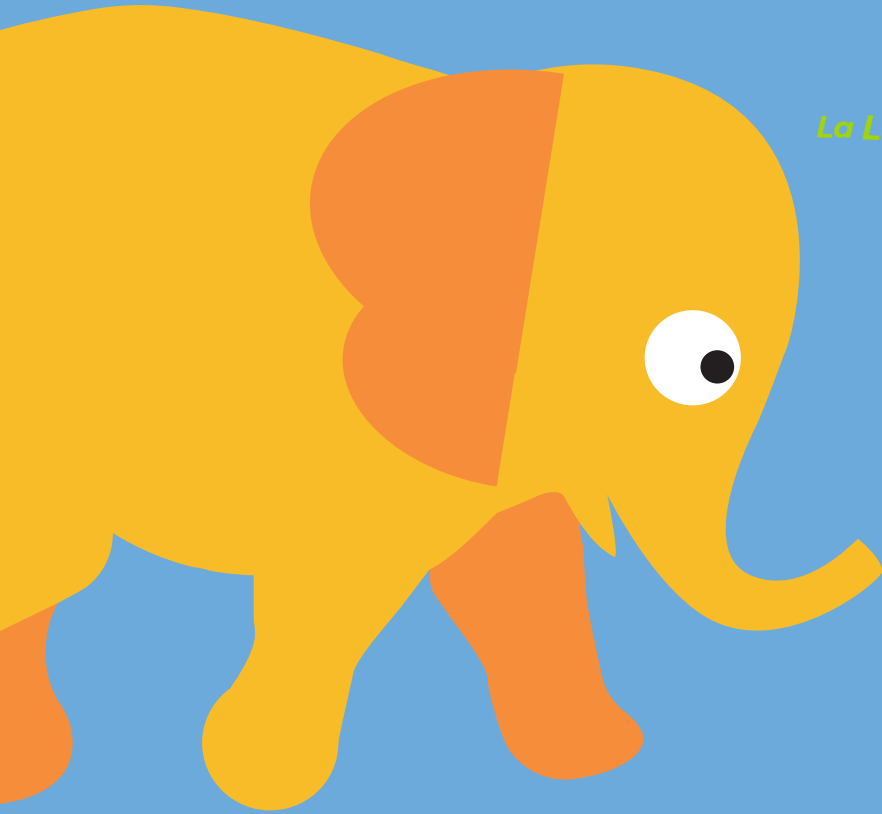
Five Fat Sausages

My voice, my voice goes tra la la.

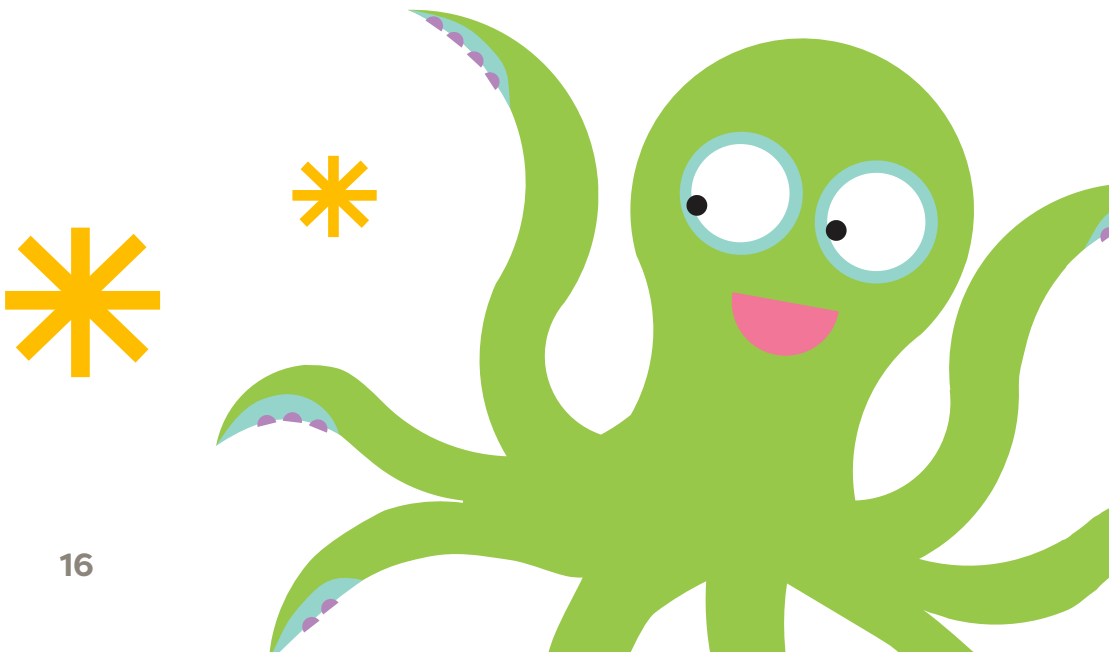
My body does the cha cha cha.
