What you need...

- + Crayola markers
- + Paper plate
- + HB pencils
- + Ruler
- + Clothespins/ pegs

What to do:

- 1. Use ruler to trace and divide upside-down paper plate into 8 equal sections.
- 2. Fill in each section with a different marker colour
- 3. On clothespin, write name of a paper plate colour in its corresponding colour. Add small colour swatch to end of clothespin.
- 4. Repeat step 3 for remaining 7 colours.
- 5. Mix up clothespins and have your child clip them to their corresponding colours. It's a fun way to help teach colour recognition!
