Animal Ears

Why?

This activity is a great way to get children talking about what they think might exist in our universe. Allowing them to create their own animal headwear gives them an opportunity to use their imagination and use different materials to craft their creations.



Instructions:

- Cut out cardboard or felt ears in any shape you like
- 2. Allow your child to decorate the ears with coloured card, textas or other craft materials you have on hand
- 3. Stick them on to the headband using glue or sticky tape.
