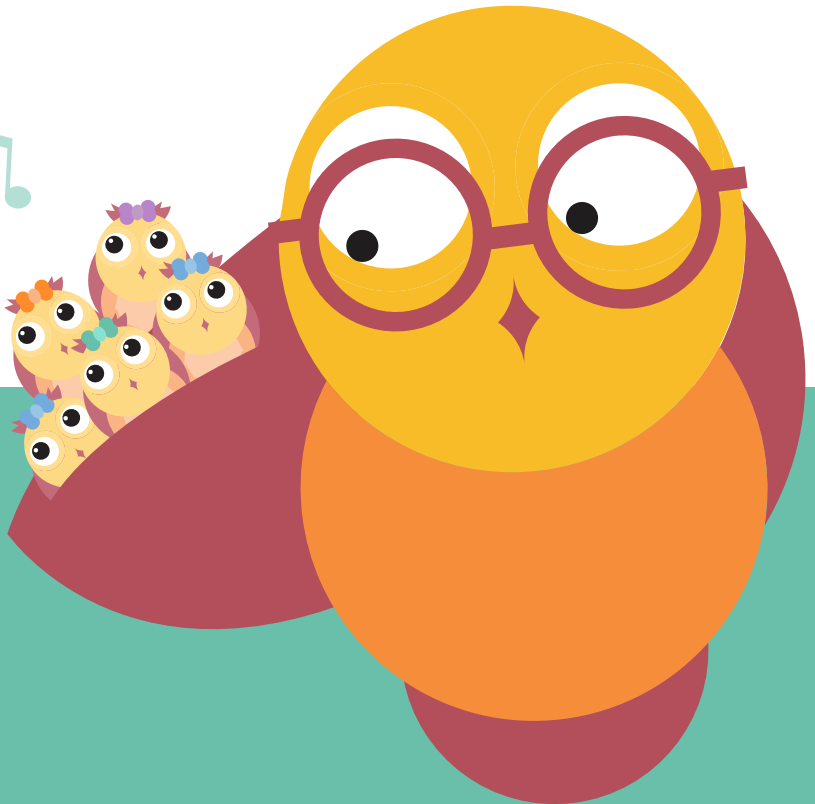

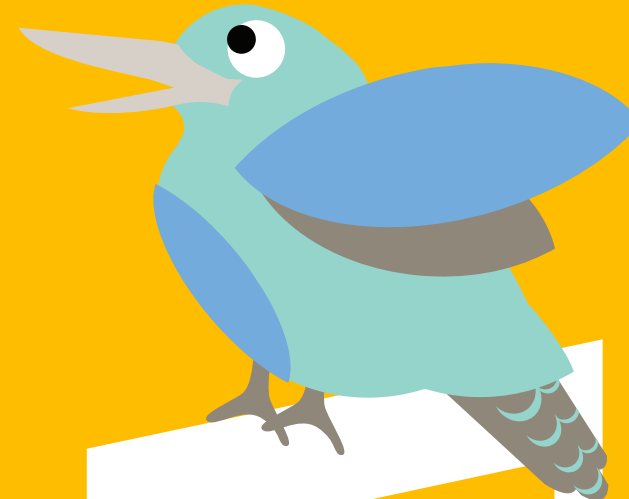

And right up in the air.



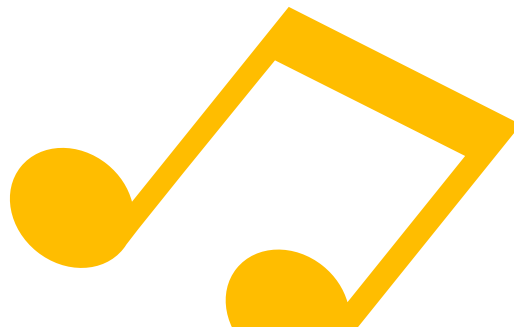
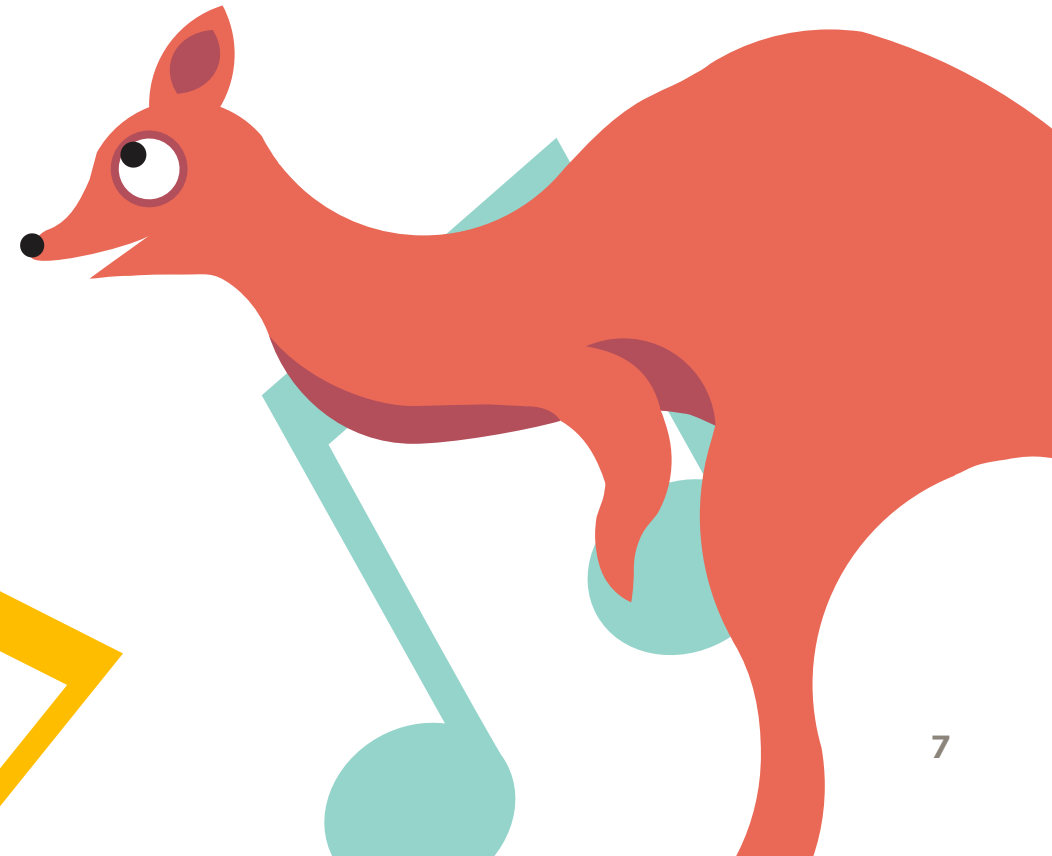
Hickory Dickory Dock

Twinkle Twinkle

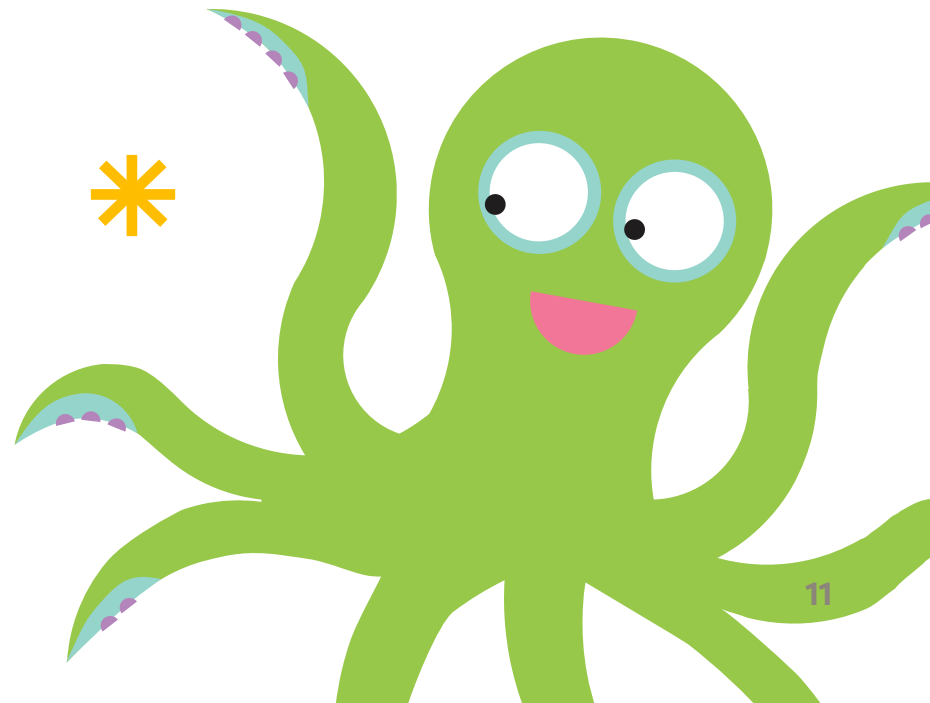
Twinkle, twinkle, little star,

How I wonder what you are!

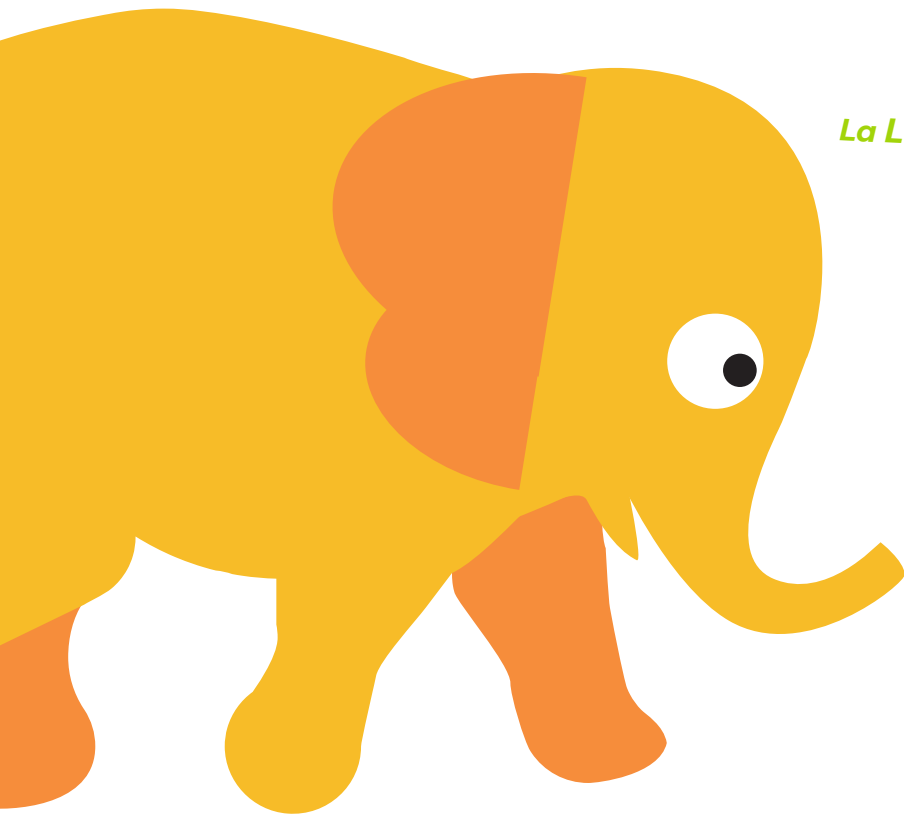
When the blazing sun is gone,

Who lives down the lane.



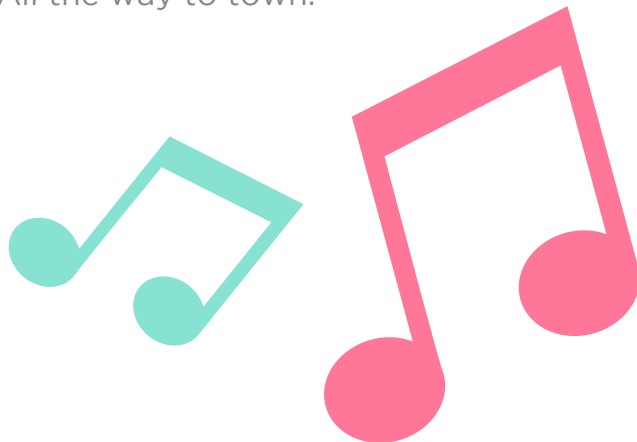
The Wheels on the Bus
