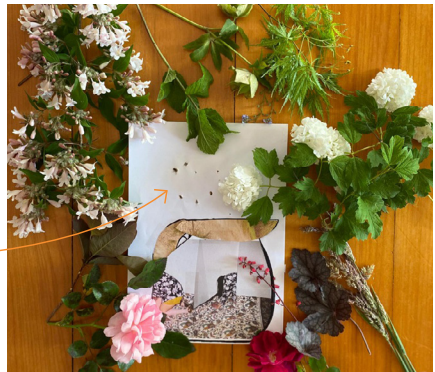
## What to do:
